Adriane Yvonne Richardson was born on October 28, 1974, in Atlanta, Georgia, to Mr. Meredith Richardson and Mrs. Leslie Y. King. She was loved, raised and nurtured by Mrs. Leslie Y. King and Dr. Winton G. King. Adriane was confirmed at St. Mark Lutheran Church in East Point, Georgia, on October 30, 1988. She graduated from Southwest Dekalb High School in 1992, and later took classes at both Dekalb Technical College and Atlanta Technical College. In 1996, Adriane started her employment as an Associate with Office Depot where she continued to work until her passing. She was a conscientious, dedicated employee who loved her job. Adriane was respected and well-regarded by all of her colleagues.

After a first family trip to Bermuda, Adriane was officially hooked on traveling at age 21. She eventually did more international travel to Puerto Rico and Dubai. She also went to Mexico and on many Caribbean cruises, and had already begun making plans for a cruise later in the year. Adriane also vacationed in Myrtle Beach, SC, many times, and she loved going on quick turnaround trips to casinos and to Arkansas to visit her nephew in college.

In addition to travel, Adriane loved music by Prince. One of the highlights of her life occurred when she went to a live Prince concert. All of us knew why purple was Adriane's color. Adriane also thoroughly enjoyed watching comedy movies and Saturday Night Live. She had an incredible sense of humor, and

was quick to laugh at her family members jokes, even the bad ones. Adriane was so gentle, humble and loving as well as known for her radiant smile. She readily accepted family members and others - flaws and all, never judging anyone.

Adriane is survived by her parents: Mrs. Leslie Y. King and Dr. Winton G. King; three siblings: Mrs. April (Elgin) Richardson Steele, Dr. Michelle (Andrew) Lyn, and Mr. Charles (Stacey) King, as well as six aunts, one uncle, nieces, nephews and a host of other relatives, friends, and loved ones.
