



Alanna Carolyn McKelvey Stone, M.D.

November 5, 1982 - July 10, 2017

Dr. Alanna Carolyn McKelvey Stone, age 34, passed on July 10, 2017 in Atlanta, Georgia. A memorial service to celebrate Dr. Stone's life will be held at Emory University Cannon Chapel at 10:30am on Saturday, July 22, with interment following at Decatur Cemetery at 2:00pm the same day.

Alanna is survived by her son, Quinlan Stone, and husband, Luke Stone, to whom she was married for nearly 8 years. Born November 5, 1982 to Jeanne Fitzgerald Dolak and Michael McKelvey, Alanna grew up in Ann Arbor, Michigan along with her brother, Alex Tashian, and sister, Aindrea Campbell.

Her brilliant career started at the University of Michigan, from which she graduated in 2004 with a bachelor of science degree. In her junior year at Michigan, she became a visiting student at the University of York in England where she met the love of her life, Luke-Pascal Stone. They eventually married in 2009 but were together for more than 14 years.

Alanna went on to achieve a master's degree from the Rollins School of Public Health at Emory University. During that time she became interested in global health and spent a summer in Uganda working with Dr. Moses Katarwa of the CDC on the distribution of ivermectin for the treatment of onchocerciasis. This research became the basis of her master's thesis.

She graduated from Rollins in 2007 and was soon after accepted at Emory University School of Medicine, completing her medical degree in 2011 with magna cum laude honors. She went on to take a prestigious residency in the Department of Internal Medicine at the University of California San Francisco. After completing her residency she did a one year General Internal Medicine Clinician Educator Fellowship.

She was thrilled to return to Atlanta in 2015 to resume her clinical practice at Grady Hospital, and further, become a junior faculty member in the Department of Internal Medicine at Emory University. In addition to teaching she also took on administrative positions at Emory. She was looking forward to working as an Assistant Program Director in Internal Medicine when her life ended abruptly on July 10 after a heroic battle against both breast cancer and leukemia.

As young as she was, she had an amazing depth of professional contributions with numerous lectures, seminars, published papers, and educational projects both here and abroad.
