May 27, 1937 - April 19, 2022

Albert Douglas Debate Frasier was born on May 27, 1937, in Charleston SC. He had one sister who preceded him to new Life, seven decades ago. He was raised by his Auntie Maybelle (Cokson) as well as several other loving family members. (With fond memories of “Stinny”)

He received top academic honors in high school. After graduation from high school, he and his best Friend William Cash decided to make the long trek from Charleston to New York to join the U.S. Army. He did enlist in the Army, joining with a MOS (Military Occupational Specialty) of Radio Operator in 1955.

Albert spoke four languages: German, Arabic, Spanish and Vietnamese, each learned from Army Foreign Language school. If you include his native Geechee Gullah he spoke five languages.

Albert served tours of duty at various Army stations including, Fort Campbell,

KY, Fort Hamilton, NY,
Fort Dix, NJ, Fort Bragg, NC, Vietnam (three tours), Munich, Germany, Fort
Gillem and Fort
McPherson, GA.

Albert attended and graduated from Officers Candidate School in 1964 at Fort
Benning, GA as
a 2nd Lieutenant (he graduated number 3 in his class).
