Allene Bernice Partee was born on September 1, 1937, to Bossie Stokes Jr. and Ora Lee McCloud in Armorel Arkansas. She attended school in Arkansas through High School where she was always active and in demand in the school plays where she was often asked to play the “mother” role. She was a natural! She accepted Christ and was baptized at a young age in her hometown of Armorel and remained faithful throughout her life. After school, Allene, with her son Larry in tow, moved to Chicago, IL for a brief period where she worked as a maid as well as other odd jobs. She soon moved to Benton Harbor, Michigan where she would meet and marry her husband of 32 years, Floyd Partee Jr. Together, they raised five children. Allene worked 25 years as a woodworker at Kaywood, Inc. in Benton Harbor until her retirement. She was a faithful member of Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church where she served in the choir as well as on the Usher Board and Mother’s Board. She was a member until she would

eventually move to Georgia upon her husband's passing.

In Georgia, Allene became an active member of Mount Moriah Baptist Church and served on

the Mother's Board. Around 2005, she would move her membership to Berean Christian Church

where she served briefly as an Usher, was an active member of the Wise and Seasoned Saints, and a graduate of the Masterfile Program. She enjoyed attending Bible Study and Sunday

service weekly. She enjoyed multiple word puzzle games and watching westerns on T.V. She

was an amazing cook and passed down her recipes to her children with love.

Allene departed this life on Thursday, October 6, 2022, at home with her children by her side.
