Amy Kirsten Williams, age 43, of Valdosta, Georgia passed away on June 23, 2022 after a courageous battle against cancer.

Amy was born on August 16, 1978 in Atlanta, Georgia. Amy graduated from Berkmar High School in 1996. Amy pursued her love of learning at Valdosta State University where she earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Speech Communication in 2000. Amy continued her educational pursuits at Valdosta State University and earned a Master of Education in Instructional Technology in 2004, Education Specialist in Instructional Technology in 2009, and Master of Arts in Communication in 2013. Amy was actively pursuing her Doctor of Education in Career and Adult Education.

In 1992, Amy met Jacob Williams during high school. Once in college, Jacob knew that Amy was “the one.” They married on May 22, 1999. Amy and Jacob, fully devoted to one another, pursued their dreams of travel and Amy’s love of adventure, in which Jacob was at times a reluctant participant. They visited locations throughout the Caribbean, Mexico, and United States in pursuit of sea and sand, and mountains and snow. From snorkeling and snow skiing to ziplining and skydiving.
