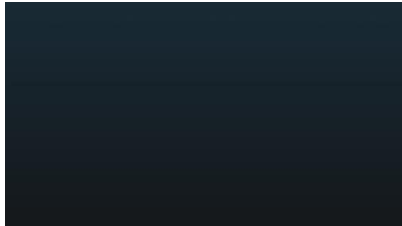

His innocent smiles and laughter illuminated his surroundings and lit up the faces of those present. The next time we saw each other was during his school years when I visited his mother; Lorna in Georgia; with two of my daughters; his cousins. He was now more charming than ever; easy to talk with, very respectful and would respond to me “Yes Ma’am.” His affection towards me was genuine; there was nothing fake about him which was evident in his love for people and the manner in which he treated them in general.



On one of his visits to Jamaica, his Grandma Ena killed one of the chickens that she had raised for food.
