He began his military career in the United States Air Force 1968 as an Inventory Management Specialist. After cross-training in Officer and Enlisted Club Management in 1976, he built a distinguished career as an Air Force Club manager until he retired. After his retirement from active duty, Marty continued his career in the same role as a civilian employee with the Department of Defense. His talents as a club manager earned him numerous awards, such as Outstanding Air Force Club Manager of the Year, Curtis La May Services Award, Best Air Force Golf Course Base, and various equivalent accolades.
