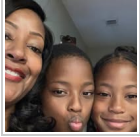

“ Tribute to Mama Anna

2013–2025: 12 Years of Friendship

Good [morning/afternoon], everyone.

My name is Jewell, and I had the honor of knowing Mama Anna for 12-13 beautiful years — a friendship that began back in 2013, when I first came to Radiation Oncology. It was a mutual friend — a transporter I was working with — who saw how hard I was working and told me, “You need to come to Radiation Oncology. You’d love it there. You gotta meet Anna.”

So we went out to lunch — I thought it was just lunch, but turns out I was being interviewed and didn’t even know it! That was Anna for you. She had to see who she was going to be working with, and make sure you were the real deal. That was her heart — protective, wise, and intentional.

Later, I had my official interview with Kelli, the manager at the time, and not long after that, I started working with Anna — and I never looked back. We worked together for years until she retired... and then came back again! Even after retirement, she still had that calling in her spirit. She gave so much of herself to her patients and to us.

Then one day, our paths shifted — Anna came back, this time not as a colleague, but as a patient. And everything changed. She sat with me in my office, opened up about how different things look when you're on the other side of the treatment table. She said to me, "I didn't realize how hard this really is... what our patients go through. This is a rough road." We shared stories, laughter, and some tears in that room. We talked about my kids, my husband, my life. That was Anna — always checking on you, even when she was the one going through something.

I called her Mama Anna for a reason. She had a mother's heart — strong, giving, nurturing, and sometimes she told you the truth even when it was hard to hear. When I was going through my own tough time, when my husband got into trouble, Mama Anna didn't just pray — she showed up. She brought money, took me out to lunch — to this chicken and waffle place in Conyers — and reminded me that I wasn't alone. That I was loved. That I was seen. She didn't just say she cared — she proved it, over and over again.

Mama Anna, thank you for every lesson, every laugh, every hug, every "check-in," every quiet moment we shared. You were more than a coworker. You were my friend. My mentor. My family. I will carry your memory and your spirit with me always. You even gave me a birthday party at your house.
