After retiring three times, she returned to teaching, where she concluded with her last year in 2020, with plans on returning prior to moving to Atlanta for health reasons.

Mississippi, for sixty-plus years, eventually serving many years as a trustee. She was

Monique, and their four children. She always stressed the importance of education,
