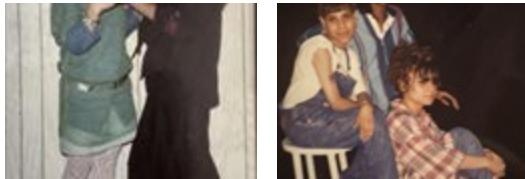
“ *Today would have been your birthday, and not a year goes by that I don't feel the weight of your absence a little heavier on this day.*
