



## Barbara Ann Campbell

February 24, 1949 - June 13, 2024

On February 24, 1949, Barbara Ann Hollis was born to the late James and Eldora Hollis in Newport, Arkansas, the eldest of three children. In her childhood, James Hollis moved his family to the city of Detroit to work in the automotive industry. This was where Barbara spent most of her childhood. Barbara kept busy with school, daily chorus practice and church activities. James Hollis was transferred to Cleveland, Ohio during Barbara's middle school years where she had to make new friends at both school and church. Always meeting new challenges head-on, Barbara excelled in academics, making honor roll most years. James Hollis was transferred back to Detroit, Michigan and Barbara was back with her old friends that she grew up with as a young child. She excelled in academics and graduated early in 1967 from Pershing High School in Detroit and began a work-study program at Michigan Bell.

In 1968, she met a young man at a party who just moved to Detroit from Chicago named James Campbell. After a few dates, their romance took off. She married James Campbell the next year on February 8, 1969. In 1982, James Campbell moved their family to College Park, Georgia and in 1984, the family moved to Decatur, Georgia. That same year, they decided to start their own business named Campbell and Campbell's Service & Repair, an HVAC company. Barbara was a dedicated and loving full-time mother and wife. Barbara loved home decorating and listening to Motown music.

Her husband preceded her transition on October 8, 2022. Their marriage lasted for 53 years. She leaves to cherish her beloved memories, three loving children Anthony Campbell, Dena Borders (John), Clifton Campbell (Shavonne), her loving sister Sharon Kilpatrick and her brother James Hollis Jr, who both preceded her in death and a host of nieces, nephews, and cousins.
