and we changed her life for the better. We usually talked to Mom every day, and she was

concerned with every detail of our lives, even the simple or silly things. Mom was always there

for us for all the important events in our lives and even just spending time around the house

doing hair or watching HGTV, Lifetime or Hallmark movies. We were best friends with Mom and

could talk to her about almost anything. Always offering her unconditional love, Mom supported

us even if she didn't fully agree with our choices.

As a free spirit, Mom loved to travel and we took countless road trips while growing up. Some of

our favorite destinations were the mountains in Gatlinburg, TN, Ruby Falls, Washington DC,

New York City, Niagara Falls, Toronto, Canada, Bryson City, NC and many more places. Mom

even drove us from Georgia to California, and our truck broke down in Mississippi - that was an adventure. When Mom worked as a grant writer for ADRA (Adventist Development Relief Agency), she had the opportunity to visit several countries in Africa, including South Africa, Ethiopia, Rwanda, Democratic Republic of the Congo. She loved adventure, embraced change, and always sought out new experiences. Everyone who knows Mom well knows that she could not stay in one place too long and would move every few years. As a lover of dancing and live music, Mom often took us to summer jazz concerts at Piedmont Park and Centennial Park in Atlanta, as well as other live jazz performances at various restaurants and performing arts centers. As a student at Grady High School, Mom played the clarinet and was a member of the school marching band. After graduating from Georgia State University with her bachelor's degree in Journalism, Mom was very ambitious with her career and passion for writing. She worked as a grant writer for many years, and raised millions of dollars for HBCUs including Tuskegee University, Savannah State, Spelman College, and Bethune Cookman and not-for-profit organizations including Boys and Girls Club, the Center for Drug-Free Living, and Aviva Family and Children's Services. In her free time, Mom loved creative writing and historical research, and has written several movie scripts and recorded short historical documentaries.

Blessed with a big heart, our mom helped others as much as she could. She loved her sisters, brothers, nieces and nephews so much, and it would bring her great joy to spend time with them and support them in any way she could. She also extended a helping hand to strangers by feeding the homeless, picking up hitchhikers, and even inviting a pregnant homeless couple to live with her, giving up her bedroom so they could have a safe place to stay. Passionate about religion and her relationship with the Almighty, Mom became very intrigued with her Hebrew roots and began studying Hebrew and observing feast days. She would often share her beliefs with others and encourage them to seek the Almighty and to have a strong personal relationship with Him. Our mom was a unique and lively person, and no one can ever replace her. Mom will forever be in our hearts, and we will always love her.

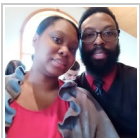
