Barry Jerome Mayfield, second son of the late Ros Mayfield and Jurrie Kate Parham Mayfield, was born January 17, 1947, in Atlanta, Georgia. He departed this life on April 7, 2022. Barry graduated from David T. Howard High School in 1965, after which he began a more than forty-year career in the retail industry working primarily in logistics. Barry was an active member of Spirit and Truth Sanctuary in Decatur, Georgia for over thirty years, where he was faithful in attendance and support.

Barry was a man of great principle, known for his gentle spirit, his kindness and generosity and his love for family and friends.
