Bessie Reid, beloved sister, cousin, aunt and friend, departed this life on July 19, 2024. She was born on November 3, 1949, in Harlem, New York to Anthony R. and Mildred E. Reid. The eldest of two children, Bessie grew up in a loving household, in St. Albans, Queens where she developed a passion for sports and soaps. She graduated from Richmond Hill High School in 1967 and then went to Mandl School, The College of Allied Health in New York City, to become a medical assistant. She worked at Equitable Life Insurance in the Medical Department and then at the Jamaica New York Board of Health.

Bessie was a committed member of Grace United Methodist Church, St. Albans, New York. From childhood, she was active in the Junior and Senior Methodist Youth Fellowship, a committed Sunday School student and sang with the Wesley's and Aldergate choirs. Later in life, she was involved in the Adult Christian Experience and Senior Adult Group. She served as secretary for local church and district conferences and was a qualified Lay Servant, having taken courses pertaining to leadership development. Typically, Bessie could be found behind the scenes doing charitable deeds for others, without wanting to be recognized. When Bessie relocated to Georgia, she transferred her quiet way of spearheading activities into the congregational life of McKendree United Methodist Church where she served with the Greeters, as well as the Hospitality and Bereavement ministries.

Bessie was a vibrant soul who embraced life with enthusiasm. She was an avid traveler who had seen the world, often finding ski destinations to explore with friends. Full of adventure, she wasn't afraid to hit the road, harness into a zipline or appreciate scenic views from a hot air balloon. A true sports fan,

committed to household rivalries, she rooted for the Mets and the Dallas Cowboys. Bessie was an experienced crocheter, generously gifting people with blankets and garments. In retirement, she frequented museums, live concerts and swimming pools (but not to swim of course). With her friends at The Main Street on the Green, Bessie organized day trips and participated in Bingo, Tai chi and bible study.

Bessie is survived by her brother Anthony R. Reid and sister-in-law Valarie Parker; her lifelong friends David and Sharon Lucas, Pat Lennon-Hicks, Brenda Angevine; her unofficial godfather and mentor Dr. Melvin Hall; and special friends Robert Bass and Nyasha Bass.
