and fussing with his caregivers for doing things differently than he wanted them done! Billie made us laugh with some of his antics, grunting voices and just general stubbornness.

Some of the times that Mr. Billie enjoyed most were the times he spent in his Day Support Program (Clayton Center), which is a center here in Clayton county that minimizes the impact of mental illness, and developmental disabilities in the lives of persons served and their families while supporting their inclusion in the community. The experiences and friends he gained were some of his most precious as he was just like everyone else when he was at the center.

He is survived by his friends and loved ones at Williams Personal Care Homes, Georgia Mentor, and Clayton Center. Billie also had many others in the community-at-large, that all played a special role in his life.
