After leaving Hereaus Amersil, he went to work for the Buford City School System, where he remained for several years until he was disabled. Deacon Moore was a faithful member of the Union Baptist church in Buford, GA, where he sang on the Male Chorus, Senior Choir and served on the Deacon Ministry until he was no longer able to physically attend and serve. Even then he still continued to support the ministry by faithfully paying his tithes.
