



Dr. Bobby Jean Moore

Bobby J. Moore was a minister and leader with over 45 years of church experience, 20 years of academics, and 25 years as an educator. From a humble beginning as a sharecropper's daughter in Zebulon, NC, she was the oldest of 8 children. Known to wake up at 3am to study, 5am-7am to work in the field, and then return to the field after school until it became dark, afterwards, study for school. So hard work became her mantra. This lifestyle shaped her thinking about God, life, and inequalities of man.

Bobby J. Moore graduated from Central Michigan University in 1972 with a Bachelor of Science and Masters in Art of Teaching with postgraduate work at University of Michigan. Extracurricular includes coaching a Pompon Team, Volleyball Team (City Champions), Chairperson of Multicultural Education Program for the Midland Public School District in Midland, Michigan (Initiated and still operating to date). Also, she received city, regional, state and 2nd in the World Champions with teams for Odyssey of the Mind. She is a retired Science and Health teacher for over 25 years who has been honored as Teacher of the Year and a leader among her peers in Michigan and Georgia. A graduate from the Teachers As Leaders Program for Gwinnett County Schools and received a Sphere of Excellence Award

Leveraging an ever-expanding portfolio of qualifications by attending mission trips to Brazil, South America with World Outreach Missions in partnership with Youth With A Mission. She ministered to the homeless children, prisoners, and evangelistic outreach in the streets. Montego, Jamaica under

leadership of Dr. Pat Bailey has missions for over 100 teens and young adults from all over the United States by marketplace skits. Also, to Africa –Nigeria, Ghana, Cote d'Ivoire, and Liberia under the leadership of Pastors Bankole and Sharon Akinmola – trained leaders, trained missionaries, built 2 churches and 3 schools in Liberia outside of Monrovia in the bush area.

Bobby was ordained from the School of Ministry at World Outreach Church for All Nations and The Father's House Church. She also attended Word Bible College in Jacksonville, FL. She specialized in training for Healing, Deliverance and Intercessory Prayer Ministry. She began her training in 2003 - Teaching by Doris Wagner, Chuck Pierce, and Kimberly Daniels. Then in 2010 – 2013 trained and certified by Restoring the Foundations Ministries in Healing and Restoration Ministry in Hendersonville, NC. Also, in 2004, Trained by Dr. Venessa Battle and serves as a part of the Regional Deliverance Team. Finally, attended an Intercessory Prayer Training – Morris Cerullo, Pastor Jacque Tyre, Intercessors 500, and World Outreach Missions

As a servant leader, she has also served the Body of Christ as a Bible Study Leader for three youth gatherings in Midland, Michigan – 1988, Third Grade Teacher and Senior Youth Advisor at Calvary Baptist Church in Midland, Michigan, and a Teacher and Assistant Sunday School Trainer - Hopewell Baptist Church – 1988. In 1996 - 2000 she was a Youth Pastor, Church Administrator, and member of the pastoral team under the leadership of Pastor Bankole Akinmola at World Outreach Church for All Nations in Tucker, GA (now in Buford, GA). In 1998 – Youth Group working with Norcross Cooperative Ministry – Christmas Gifts for Children, 2010 - 2012 - Free Turkey with Fixing Ministry For Community working with Norcross Cooperative Ministries, 2013 – launched the Weekend Food Backpack Ministry for middle school with 90% of the students on a reduced and free lunch program, and 2008 – 2011 - TRAPP (Teaching Respect, Appreciation, Purpose and Pride) – Worked with students in grades 6th through 8th on etiquette, finances, goal setting, study skills and operating in excellence. She is also part of the Kingmakers Women's Ministry (local, national, and soon to be an international

women's ministry) serves as Prayer Ministry Director, and part of the administrative team in the home office in Norcross, GA. Also, she has served as a workshop facilitator for the yearly conference for five (5) years from 2009 - 2014.

Most recently, served as member on the Board of Trustee for the Teachers Retirement System of Georgia with a budget of over \$57 billion. She is one of the Pastors and Elder at The Father's House in Norcross, GA under the leadership of Bishop Wellington Boone. Additionally, serves as Lead intercessor, overseer of the First time Guests, Member Care, recipient of the Wellington Boone Leadership Award, and Eikon Award for Leader of the Year for two (2) years in a row.

Bobby's life demonstrates that against seemingly insurmountable odds, one can still rise above these odds and succeed in life. Her favorite saying is "You are Seeds of Greatness! What your mind can conceive and you believe, you can achieve." Further identifying with her favorite Scriptures: Genesis 1: 26-28 that describes our identity in God, our Heavenly Father; Isaiah 61: 1-9 was also close to her heart because it describes what we she is to do to promote the Kingdom of God and to dismantle the Kingdom of Darkness.

She is survived by her husband, Percy Moore; Daughter Angela Leverett; Son, Reginald Johnson; Son-in-law, Christopher Leverett; Granddaughter, Auraleah Leverett, Brother, Ricky Holman; Sister, Rose Holman; Brother Randy Holman; Sister Debbie Holman; Sister Adina Johnson; and Swannie Manley; along with many stepchildren and step-grandchildren. The funeral will be at 1:00pm on Saturday, June 20, 2015 at The Father's House in Norcross, GA; 5875 Peachtree Industrial Boulevard, Suite 300, Norcross, GA 30092.
