On August 2, 2023, Brooke Sierra Jackson, loving daughter, sister, and friend, passed away at the age of 27. Brooke had a vibrant, curious, and infectious personality. She loved bright colors, animals, dancing, making uncanny impressions, digital productivity and organizational tools, marketing, and videogames. She loved her family and her friends, and they loved her. Her ability to bring laughter, happiness, and positivity to any situation left a lasting impact on everyone fortunate enough to know her. Brooke's memory will continue to live on through the love and fond memories shared by her family and friends.

Brooke was born on March 1, 1996 in Atlanta, Georgia. She was the third daughter of Dr. Ralph Abraham Jackson and Edith Annette Brodie Jackson. She was the youngest sister of Brittani Alexandria Jackson and Bianca Simone Jackson.

In May 2023, Brooke graduated from Georgia State University with a

bachelor's degree in marketing. She was a Social Media Manager at Black Girls Smile, a nonprofit that provided mental health support and empowerment for Black girls and young women. And she recently began a position as a Digital Marketing Intern at National Veterinary Associates.

Brooke was preceded in death by her grandparents, Ruby Spivey Brodie, Ruby Mamie Lang Jackson, and Abraham Jackson; and her aunt, Evalon Adlean Brodie Lewis.
