Carol Jean Doctor-Jones affectionately called “ Jean”, of Lawrenceville, Georgia, was born on February 27th, 1948 in Richland County, South Carolina to Carrie E. Davis-Doctor and James Doctor, Sr., who preceded her in death. Her Step-Mother Geraldine Alford-Doctor, who also preceded her in death. On Wednesday night, April 29, 2020 she went home to be with the Lord at Northside Hospital in Lawrenceville, Georgia. She attended the public schools Richland County. After graduating from C. A. Johnson High School in 1966, she completed her first semester of College at Benedict College in Columbia, SC in 1967. She met and married Jesse L. Jones, Sr. from 1967 – 1983 and with that union they had 3 children. While in the U.S. Army , the family moved to the following places Fort Bragg, North Carolina, Nuremberg, Germany and then to Fort Ord, California where she went back to college. In June of 1979 she graduated from Monterey Peninsula College with an Associate Degree in General Business. She worked in Civil Service on Fort Ord until 1993 due to the closing of the Army Base. In December of

1993 she moved to Indianapolis, Indiana to continue working as an Accountant for Department of Defense until she retired on December 31, 2009. While living in Indiana, she continued to further her education by attending and graduating from Indiana Wesley University with a BA in Management and a 3.887 grade point average with honors.

Carol was a praying woman and she loved the Lord all the way up until her passing. While living in California she met a lot of friends and she loved going to church where she was very active in Church Services. For example she was a member of New Hope Baptist Church where she was the Announcement Clerk, Choir Member, Youth Workshop Facilitator, Chair-Person for the Young Adult Women Auxiliary. Then she was President of the Missionary Society and choir member at Holy Assembly. When she lived in Indianapolis, Indiana, she was the Choir Director and Sunday School Superintendent at Mt. Gerizim Baptist Church and the Prison Ministry at Eastern Star Baptist Church.

Carol was full of joy and laughter. She was also a people person she never met a stranger and she loved helping people especially when it came to our friends. She loved them all as if they were her children and they all called her "mom". Besides being a mother to her 3 children and their friends, her greatest title of all time is being called a Grandma! She loves all of grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
