Carolyn Elizabeth Lee Gordon, age 89, of Decatur, Georgia, passed peacefully on June 30, 2025. Born in Jennings, Louisiana, she was the eldest of seven children of the late Joe Lee and Victoria Simon.

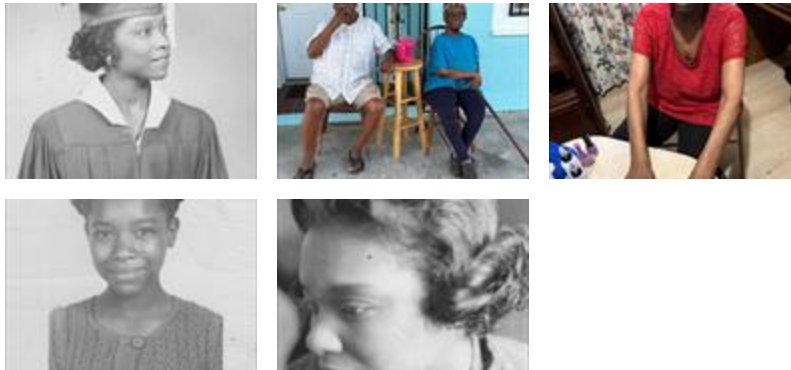
