Born on July 25, 1981, to loving parents Miguell Clarke and Dahlia Clarke, Castin immediately filled the lives of those around him with joy. Castin was active in his local church, Padmore Seventh-day Adventist Church and ultimately spearheaded the Adventist Youth Society, the youth choir, and several acapella groups.
