Born on June 30, 1937, in Kingston, Jamaica, Cecil was the fourth of eleven children born to Egbert and Doris Parkinson. His childhood was steeped in warmth and laughter, growing up in a vibrant household filled with siblings, cousins, and enduring memories. In 1960, he married the love of his life, Barbara, and together they welcomed their son, Andrew.

Cecil's academic journey began at Kingston Technical High School and continued at the University of the West Indies, where he earned a Bachelor of Science in Accounting. While pursuing his degree, he worked at the Jamaica Public Service (JPS) Company, where he rose through the ranks from staff accountant to finance manager, eventually becoming treasurer. His commitment and excellence earned him a place at the University of Michigan's Executive Graduate Program for public utility executives. After 20

years of service at JPS, Cecil and his family relocated to New York.

In New York, Cecil continued his professional journey at Maritime Inc., where he served with distinction for over two decades as finance manager and later as a statistician. He retired in 2003 and settled in Grayson, Georgia, where he and Barbara spent treasured years close to their grandchildren, Brandon and Gillian.

Though more of a spectator than a player, Cecil had a deep appreciation for sports—football, baseball, basketball, golf, and cricket all brought him joy. He also had a passion for travel, especially cruising through the Caribbean and exploring Europe.

Cecil will be remembered for his generous spirit and quiet strength. He was patient, principled, and deeply committed to his family. His strong work ethic and gentle nature were the foundation of a life well-lived and will continue to inspire generations to come.

He was preceded in death by his siblings Henry, Lenny, Carlton, and Constance. He is survived by Madge, Jimmy, Rudolph, Tommy, Douglas, and Dottie.

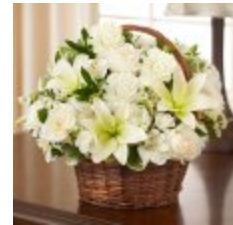
