Chardae “Prima” Regina Sanders was born on November 6, 1986 in Atlanta, Georgia at Crawford Long Hospital. She is the daughter of Regina “Mama Prima” Sanders and the late Bobby Gene Sanders of Decatur, Georgia.

Chardae “Prima” started her education at Browns Mill Elementary School in Stonecrest, Georgia. She was a student of the Inaugural class of E.L. Bouie Elementary Theme School in Lithonia, Georgia. She later attended Miller Grove Middle School, and graduated from Southwest Dekalb High School in Decatur, Georgia in 2005, where she was voted most humorous of her senior class. She graduated from Georgia State University Perimeter College with an Associate of Arts Degree in Mass Communications in 2012 and from Kennesaw State University in Kennesaw, Georgia, with a Bachelor’s of Science Degree in Communications and History in 2015. Her honors and accomplishments include: being recognized as a Who’s Who Honor student, receiving an Honor’s Award for Adult Learners at Kennesaw State University, and becoming the first African American Vice President of the Public Relations Student Society of America (PRSSA), and a staff writer for the Kennesaw State University Sentinel.

Chardae “Prima” was a dedicated advocate for kidney disease awareness.

She founded “PrimaStrong” to educate and empower people to help prevent kidney disease. PrimaStrong was her vision, and her legacy of advocacy for kidney patients will certainly continue as Mama Prima and the team continue to advance it forward. She was an Ambassador for the American Association of Kidney Patients (AAKP) and a National Advocate for the National Kidney Foundation (NKF). Prima was the face of the National Kidney Foundation Cares Campaign in 2014- 2015 and was given the honor of speaking to the U.S. Congress as a National Advocate for kidney disease awareness.

Chardae “Prima” was a mentor for many people even while facing her own medical challenges. She humbly spoke into others’ lives as she helped to lead them to Christ. She helped to mentor and encourage others to focus on their destiny. She was a loving, caring, personable and compassionate mentor for others. She diligently followed the valuable lessons and biblical guidance that was taught by her parents as she walked out the biblical guidance to truly be a blessing to others.

Chardae “Prima” was employed by A3C Festival & Conference as the Director of Executive Sales. She was employed by State Farm Insurance as an Internet Support Specialist. She was previously employed by A1 Promotions ATL LLC as an Assistant General Manager.

Chardae “Prima” was a member of New Birth Baptist Church in Stonecrest, Georgia for many years. She received the Lord Jesus Christ as her Savior at a young age. She loved engaging with the youth and ministry leaders in the Youth Ministry under the leadership of Pastor Eddie Velez. She was involved in ministry by sharing with young ladies and speaking into their lives.

Chardae “Prima” was called home to be with the Lord on February 13, 2021. Her dearly beloved Father, Bobby Gene Sanders, preceded her in death. She

leaves to cherish her memory, her dearly beloved Mother, Regina Sanders “Mama Prima”; her older brother, Cecil Benny Armstrong II (and his wife, Shatika); and a host of loving Uncles, Aunts, cousins and many friends.
