Mrs. Cloutil Shipman Davis was born August 7, 1949, to William and Mavis Shipman of Ozark, Alabama (Dale County). In 1950, the family moved to Lubbock, Texas. 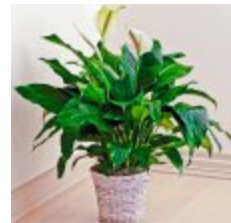
