Cora Lee Singleton was born September 7th, 1944, in Beaufort, SC to the late Janie Bell Singleton and Abraham Brown. Two of her brothers preceded her in death, Henry and Alan Singleton.

Cora graduated from Port Jefferson H.S. in Port Jefferson, NY. During these formative years she embraced life's changes from living in the south with her grandmother, to moving to Long Island, NY and at the age of nine she was sent to live with her mother in Harlem, NY.

She was employed as a factory worker, then decided to go to Nursing School, but found out very quickly she did not have the stomach for the job. She worked for Manufacturers Hanover Trust, which is now J.P. Morgan Chase Bank, with 30 years of dedicated service, retiring at the age of 57 in 2007.

Cora was a very proud woman, who took pride in everything connected to her; to the way she dressed, spoke, carried herself and the cleanliness of her home and children.
