A Time to be Born

Crispin Kalongo wa Mutombo was affectionately known by his family and friends as Criskalo. He was born on Wednesday, September 15, 1943, in a town called Mweka, a town in southern-central Democratic Republic of the Congo, situated on the Kasai railway line between Kananga and the Kasai River port of Ilebo. He was born to the parents, Marie Mujinga Tshiamala and Pierre Mutombo Dizaji; both preceded him in death. Criskalo had two brothers and four sisters.

A Time to Live and a Time to Reflect

Criskalo's education began at a primary school in Bulongo, Kasai occidental. He continued on to Middle and High School at Athénée Royale de la Gombe, in Kinshasa. For his advanced education, he attended the Louvanium University of Kinshasa (today UNIKIN) where he graduated with a Bachelor Degree in Economics, Business and Social Science.

During his confessional and associative life, Criskalo was a devout Catholic believer. Couple of days before his death he asked his beloved wife to bless and pray for him. He was a faithful attached to the parish of "Sacre Coeur" (Catholic Church in Kinshasa), where he was a member of their choir during the Latin Mass every Sunday. When he came to Atlanta, "Mary Our Queen" became his new Catholic Church home. He was member of the: CVV, the

Association “Anciens de Bulongo of Josephites Fathers”, the Political party UDPS, and the Lions Club.

Crispin Kalongo wa Mutombo was extremely sick. He came to the US in March of 2018 for medical treatment. Our God decided to call him back next to him on Thursday, May 24, 2018.

A Time to Mourn, Weep and a Time to Remember

Crispin Kalongo wa Mutombo is survived by his wife, Louise Elizabeth Ntumba Tshibuabua. They met in Kinshasa, when he was 26 years old and she was 18 years. They have been together for more than 49 years. He is also survived by his four children, Sons: Karl Tshibumba Kalongo (Tshitshi for family and friends), Junior Kalongo wa Kalongo, Dizzy Kalongo (who preceded him in death in August 2001); Daughters: Sophie Marie Madeleine, Esther Mujinga Kalongo Louise Elisabeth Ntumba Kalongo; 4 grand children, Dodi Kalongo, Laurentina Ntumba Mukania, Nissy Kalongo, and Loulou Ntumba Kalongo whom he loved dearly. They always brought him laughter and happiness whenever he would talk to them.

His memory will forever be loved and cherished in the hearts of his loved ones.
