At an early age De'Aundrey was introduced to the word of God by his Godmother Catherine Albrighten and his two aunts Brenda Hardaway and Cynthia Keen where he gained a desire to seek after the absolute truth as it pertained to the word of God.

In 1995 De'Aundrey whom everyone affectionately called Drey, graduated from Fulton High School (South Atlanta). Drey was a born leader. He has

He performed his duties as a Deputy Sheriff Master while assigned to the DeKalb County court division. In 2011, Drey started Heirs of the Promise Ministry Inc. with a YouTube channel known as Abraham's Seed where he taught in the name of Yahusha. Drey took an early retirement due to his illness in October 2016. Also in 2016 Drey, along with his friend Kenneth Anthony started another YouTube channel known as Spiritual Scent Gents where they gave detailed reviews on fragrances.

Drey was known for his infectious Smile, his love for the Most High God, and The Atlanta Falcons. Drey loved to laugh and joke. Drey's goal was to create a life that he would not need a vacation from. He was very meticulous about his family, his style of dress and his home.
