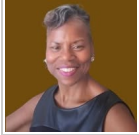

I believe I first met the Cantys in 1971 or 1972 when I was serving at Suehn Mission and Sister Erma Etheridge and I were visiting Bopolo Bible Mission. I remember marveling upon seeing Mrs. Canty and maybe Mrs. Trusty both pushing baby carriages. Rev. Canty was often invited to Suehn to preach an encouraging message to the boarding students. “ It was around this time in 1995 when Elder Canty headed a team of dedicated missionaries from New Birth Missionary Baptist Church, Lithonia, to Christ the Lord Gospel Church, Ghana-West Africa. On his arrival, his able leadership, humility, and desire for cross-cultural evangelism and help for the needy carried us to the Northern regions of Ghana to help spread the gospel and address the spiritual, physical, material, and social needs of Muslims, pagans and Christians alike in this economically impoverished parts of Ghana. We visited the Liberian refugee camps with trucks of relief aids under Elder Canty's leadership. In collaboration with our founder, apostle Emmanuel K. Apau, Elder Canty organized leadership seminars for local church leaders. His return to the US and report to Bishop Eddie Long about his experience in Ghana opened new doors for Christ the Lord Gospel church. Through Elder Canty, New Birth Missionary Baptist Church, bought a van for our Outreach ministries and supported us financially for the next five years. Bishop Long in collaboration with Elder Canty secured a minibus for our church activities. These acts of kindness enabled Christ the Lord's Gospel to plan more local branches. In the year, 2000, Pastor Canty visited Ghana again for more missionary outreach efforts and the ordination of Pastor Elijah Apau.

The inputs and sacrifice of Pastor Donald Canty in Ghana is now expanding Christ the Lord Gospel Church to Europe and currently, a branch is underway in the USA.

Pastor Canty, your work, your encouragement to our apostle, your humility, and your name will always be remembered. We are celebrating you in Ghana now and in Europe. Our, apostle, Emmanuel K. Apau is thankful to God for your life and for your accomplishment in his ministry as a co-servant in the Lord's vineyard.

Rest in peace, God's army general. You fought a good fight and finish well. What awaits you now is Christ's promised crown of eternal glory. Receive it in Jesus' name!
