November 18, 1946 - June 23, 2024

Mrs. Dorothy Jean Williams, daughter of Alphonso and Betty White (both deceased), was born on November 18th, 1946, in Scottdale, Georgia. She was one of nine siblings. She attended elementary school at Robert Shaw Elementary Theme school and graduated from Hamilton High school as the Class of 1964, in Scottdale, Georgia, she was a stellar student with a great talent in Mathematics. Dorothy was full of life and her home was a shelter for anyone who needed a hot meal, a kind word and a lot of love and laughter. Her home was always filled with the best of Motown,

Ray Charles, food cooking nonstop, 3 AM check ins, huge celebrations, and getting the entire family matching gifts. Everyone knew “Aunt Dot” would be there for you no matter the circumstance and no matter how the world saw you. She was the embodiment of unconditional love with a no-nonsense delivery.
