Dorothy Young was born in Augusta, Georgia on March 29th, 1954. She departed this life on Saturday, January 11th, 2025. Dorothy was the sixth (6) lineage of ten (10) children born to the union of David and Minnie Bell Lanham who preceded her in death. Dorothy was educated in the Richmond County public school system and graduated from Westside High School in May 1972. She attended Paine College, where she met her future husband Lester Young Jr. The couple was married on December 11th, 1976 and remained married until her death. From this union three children were born, Lester “Rocky” Young III, Brandon Lanham Young and Nykki Iman Young. They also have two granddaughters, Niomi Arianna Young and Abrianna Nicole Young.

Dorothy received her License Practical Nurse (LPN) license in 1976 from the Augusta Area Technical School (Lawton B. Evans Nursing School). She worked in the medical field for over Forty (40) years, spending time in Haiti doing missionary work with “Doctors Without Borders”. In March 2020, she decided to finally retire.
