



## Apostle Dr. Nancy West

December 9, 1941 - October 24, 2015

Apostle Dr. Nancy West (née Ross) of Lithonia, GA went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, October 24th at the age of 73. Dr. West is survived by her two (2) children, Lenzy Darren West, Sr. of College Park, GA and Kristine Gia Gilbert (née West) of Paget, Bermuda, her five (5) grandsons, Lenzy Darren West, Jr. of Englewood, NJ, Darryl George Rivers, Jr. and wife Felithia (née Freeman) of Marietta GA, Vincent Michael West, of Englewood NJ, Josiah Jair Gilbert of Lithonia, GA and Jerijah Zaccheus West of Englewood NJ. She is also survived by her two (2) great granddaughters, Elaina Khristine Rivers and Emeri Kalia Rivers and one great grandson Vincent Michael West, Jr., as well as her loving sister Mildred (née Ross) and husband John Roper of Passaic NJ. She is also survived by a host of nieces, nephews, great nieces, great nephews, cousins and friends. She was also a “Mother in Zion” with many spiritual children.

She is preceded in death by siblings Maxine (née Ross) Johnson of Passaic NJ, Albert Ross of Passaic NJ, Mack Henry Ross of Paterson NJ and Thomas Ross of Passaic NJ.

Dr. West was born on December 9th, 1941 in Passaic, NJ to parents Mack and Mary (née Martin) Ross. Apostle Dr. Nancy West was an Apostolic/Prophetic teacher and trainer, who had a heart for training leaders to effectively equip the saints for the work of the ministry. She was an anointed “watchman on the wall” who had an ear to hear what the Spirit of the Lord was saying to His church, and to discern the tactics of the kingdom of darkness.

Dr. West served faithfully for over 25 years ministering in local churches and as a guest speaker, both domestically and internationally. She was twice ordained as a Prophet of God, first in 1993 at King of Kings Full Gospel Tabernacle in Hackensack NJ, and then in 1998 at Christian International in Santa Rosa Beach, FL, and ordained there again as an Apostle in 2002. She received her fourth ordination on February 11th, 2007 as an Elder at New Birth Missionary Baptist Church in Lithonia GA. She founded Outflow Ministries International; the Prophetic Apostolic Worshiping Network of Saints (P.A.W.N.S.) and O.M.I. - Online Apostolic Prophetic Ministry College.

Dr. West studied vigorously to show herself approved unto God, and continuously advanced her knowledge and understanding of the Word of God. She received an Associate's Degree in Prophetic Ministry from Christian International Ministry Training College in Santa Rosa Beach, Florida. She then attained a Bachelor of Theology degree from Christian International School of Theology, Santa Rosa Beach, Florida. After which she went on to receive both Master's and Doctorate degrees from Wagner Leadership Institute, Colorado Springs, Colorado. She received her second Doctorate degree, a Doctorate of Ministry in Theology, from Life Christian University, Lutz, Florida. Her interest in Inner Healing and Deliverance led her to receive training in integrated ministry as a Prophetic Prayer Counselor of Restoring the Foundations.

Her homegoing service is scheduled for Monday, November 2nd 1:00 p.m. at New Birth Missionary Baptist Church officiated by Bishop Isaiah McKinnon.
