Dwight Lamarr Williams was born December 14, 1969, to loving parents, Arthur and Barbara Williams, at Manatee Memorial Hospital in Bradenton, FL. He was the first-born son of his six siblings. In 1992 Dwight decided to serve his country by joining the United States Army where he served for four years.
