Alieron Brown, Jr., age 39. Daddy boy, Ed, Babe, Daddy, as he was affectionately called, was a longtime resident of Loganville, Georgia. Edmond passed away on Wednesday, October 2, 2024 at Piedmont Walton Hospital, Monroe, GA.

Born on October 19, 1984, in Monrovia, Liberia, Edmond was the son of Edmond Alieron Brown, Sr. and Massa (Walker) Brown. After graduating from Saint Raphael Academy of Pawtucket, RI with the class of 2002, where he was a star Linebacker for the football team, Edmond went on to attend Saint Augustine's University, Raleigh, NC.

Edmond later embarked on a distinguished career in Martial Arts and Brazilian jiu-jitsu. He was the founder and former owner of Patriot Karate and Martial Arts and an incredible martial artist and mentor. As a 5th degree black belt in American Karate and a blue belt in Brazilian jiu-jitsu, Edmond dedicated his life to mastering his craft and sharing his passion with the community. He taught hundreds of students, including children and adults. He taught discipline, respect, and a sense of purpose to his students. He later went on to work for Panel Steel Inc. from 2020 until his untimely death.

Edmond left a huge legacy of his vision and dedication which made Patriot Karate and Martial Arts the successful business it is today. His legacy ensures that he will never be forgotten.

In addition to his professional accomplishments, Edmond was an active member of his community.

His dedication to families in his community was unwavering. Edmond's greatest joy was his two sons, of whom he was immensely proud of. He cherished quality time with family and friends, enjoying the New England Patriots, spending time gardening while sharing gardening tips with his Mom, vacationing with his Fiancée and Partner and his sons, Sunday family dinners and holidays celebrations at his Mom's.
