When I convinced him to get the watch to monitor his vitals like mine, we would review I vitals at the beginning of each shift, mid shift, and the end of shift. He always got a kick out of us doing that.

My heart is heavy with the news of my coworker and friend Edward French passing. We worked a lot of years overnight doing security, and he was always a bright spirit. We had many conversations over the years about life's challenges. He was always a poster for how a security professional should look in uniform, and perform assigned duties.
