Elder Jimmie Lee Williams went home to be with the Lord early Sunday morning December 5, 2021, at 4:30 a.m. Jimmie was born to Ms. Johnnie Mae Fountain and Mr. Richard Reed. He was then adopted by relative, Mr. Alto Williams. He was educated through the Bay County School System in Panama City, Florida. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War, and was honorably discharged. He married his high school sweetheart, Ms. Minnie Pearl Harris on July 13, 1968.

Elder Jimmie Williams accepted the Lord as his personal Savior, and his call to the ministry at Neal's Temple First Born Church of the Living God in Panama City, Florida. He was a professional truck driver and entrepreneur. He began his own business in route sales and distribution for his company, J.W. Distributing. He retired in August 2018.
