Eldredge Robinson, 91, of Lithonia, GA, passed away on May 7, 2020 at home surrounded by family.

He was born in Eupora, MS on August 14, 1928, son of the late Frank and Lelia Robinson. He married Wintha Jean Winston in 1953. They had eight children; seven daughters and one son. He was a loving and devoted husband and father. He was a religious man that believed in the teachings of Jesus Christ and led a life which embodied those teachings through faith, love, kindness, and fairness. Thank you. I love you Dad.

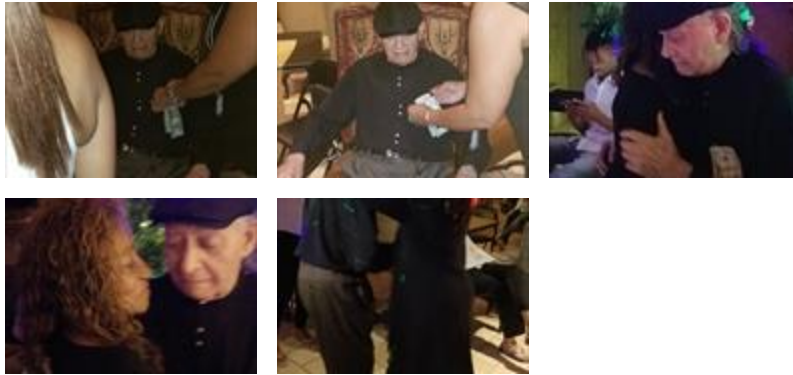
