### BIOGRAPHY

#### Introduction

Nene Martey Angmeh II, also known as Mr. Emmanuel Martey Jr, but affectionately called “Emmanuel” by his dear wife Barbara; “Papa” by his

children; “Easy E” by his stepchildren, was born on January 12th, 1948 at Osu, Accra in the Greater Accra Region of Ghana to Police Inspector Emmanuel Martey Sr. and Madam Mary Adorkor Aborhey, both of blessed memory.

### Early Life and Education

Inspector Emmanuel Martey Sr. being a police officer, was prone to frequent transfers to almost every part of Ghana. Whenever and wherever he was transferred to, he went with his son, Emmanuel. Emmanuel attended almost every Primary and Middle School in Ghana, until he gained admission into Tema Secondary School (now Tema Senior High School) in September 1963. He was awarded Ghana Cocoa Marketing Board (CMB) Scholarship for his outstanding performance during the Common Entrance Examination for admission into secondary school. Having had the opportunity to travel with his father across the length and breadth of Ghana, he developed great interest in animal rearing. Immediately after his secondary school education and having passed his “O” Level exam in 1968, he enrolled into the Kwadaso Agricultural College in Kumasi to be trained in Animal Husbandry. Upon completion of Kwadaso in 1971, he was appointed as an Agric Extension Officer to Tamale Municipal Area. After a few years in Tamale, he relocated to his hometown, Prampram and continued with his career as an Agric Extension Officer, serving Ningo-Prampram, Kpone, Ada, and parts of Greater Accra Region. His love for animals made him take a giant step to establish his own Poultry Farm at Prampram. He employed many workers into his Farm.

### Family and Christian Life

Emmanuel Martey Jr was family oriented. He understood very early in life that education enables upward socioeconomic mobility and that it was key to escaping poverty. He invested so much effort and resources into the education of his children, stepchildren, and grandchildren. He encouraged and provided all needed school resources and materials for them. Never had any

of his beneficiaries dropped out of school. Emmanuel understood the essence of motivation as a condition that activates and sustains. He taught his children, stepchildren, cousins, nephews, and nieces to soar like eagles and aspire to achieve the highest levels of education as much as they possibly could. Emmanuel got along with all his brothers and sisters; uncles and aunties; nieces and nephews; and cousins. He became a patriarch in both his paternal and maternal families. He was a consultant extraordinaire, at whose feet many came to learn family values and etiquette. At the extended family level, Emmanuel played vital roles as the Okyeame Onukpa (Chief Linguist) of the Prampram Traditional Council. In the USA where he was resident, he was Chief Linguist for the Ga-Adangme Community. He officiated in baby-naming ceremonies, Homowo Festivals and always insisted that things were done right.

Nene Angmeh II bore true faith and allegiance to Christ and to the Church throughout his life and in all his endeavors he kept to his Maker. He was a devout Christian, a Methodist through and through and raised his family with his religious morals. He was baptized into the Methodist faith, and later confirmed into the Methodist Church. As a staunch member, he never hid his identity as a proud Methodist. Emmanuel would never spare any pastor who misquotes a Bible verse during a sermon. After the pastor's sermon he would tell the pastor: "Next time, you must learn to quote the appropriate verse before you mount the pulpit to preach to us."

### Final Days

Just like the eyes of the disciples were opened after the resurrection of Christ and they began to understand clearer the things that He had spoken to them prior to his death, we are now in retrospect beginning to see clearly that Emmanuel started giving us hints of his departure right from last year. We did not fully understand his phone calls to people in his life, but now we know he called them to bid farewell to brothers, sisters, cousins, old friends and many

more. In fulfillment of his desires, we are holding his funeral and memorial here, at this funeral home. We also now understand why a month or two before his departure, he dictated and commissioned the writer of this biography to write it and insisted that it should be read upon his departure. He even spoke to the writer of this biography for 28 minutes on Sunday and 20 minutes on Monday, and on Tuesday July 9, 2024, he passed on to eternity peacefully.

#### Conclusion

Emmanuel was a man full of determination who worked hard in the face of adversity to provide for his loved ones, children and others. Many came to his home for nourishment and succor. He was the people's dad. No wonder everyone called him Papa, whether young or old. His name has been etched on the hearts of everyone who knew him. He left behind 2 children (one predeceased), 5 stepchildren, 7 grandchildren; 10 siblings; cousins; nephews and nieces. We love you and you will be missed terribly. Till we meet again, Nene Martey Angmeh II, rest peacefully in the Lord.
