Eric David Maina Kamau, age 52 of Snellville, GA; passed away on Tuesday, October 13, 2020.

Eric was born in Dar es-Salaam, Tanzania on August 8th, 1968 to the late Benson Kamau and Beatrice Njeri but spent much of his childhood in Kenya. He migrated to the US in 1993 and attended University of Maryland Baltimore County (UMBC) where he earned a bachelor's degree in computer information systems. In 1995 Eric and his family moved to Georgia and later settled in Snellville. Eric worked for several companies in Maryland and in Georgia. In 2019 he started a small business in pharmaceutical logistics.

Eric was passionate about education. He was always learning something new. It was his belief that good strong education builds knowledge and knowledge is power. Eric loved Lingala music! He loved it so much that when his daughter, Beatrice, played Lingala music at the hospital bedside, he opened his eyes several times, something he had not done for 24 hours. Eric also enjoyed watching sports, most notably Football and Basketball.

On September 20, 2020, he was in an automobile accident. He spent 3 weeks at Emory University Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries on October 13, 2020 at 9.05 pm.

Eric is survived by his wife Jane Waithira Karanja, Daughter Beatrice Njeri Maina, Son Benson Kamau Maina, his mother Beatrice Njeri Kamau, sisters Charity Wangari Njoroge, Eunice Ng'endo Wanyoike and brother Gideon Kung'u Kamau, of Kiambu, Kenya; in-laws, many nieces, nephews, and relatives.
