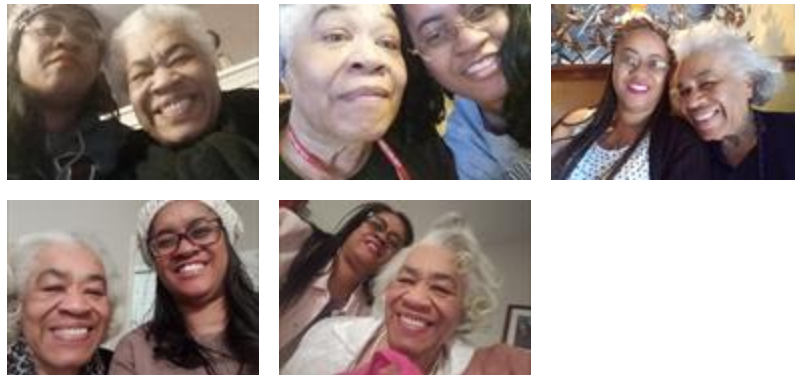
May 27, 1938 - November 22, 2021

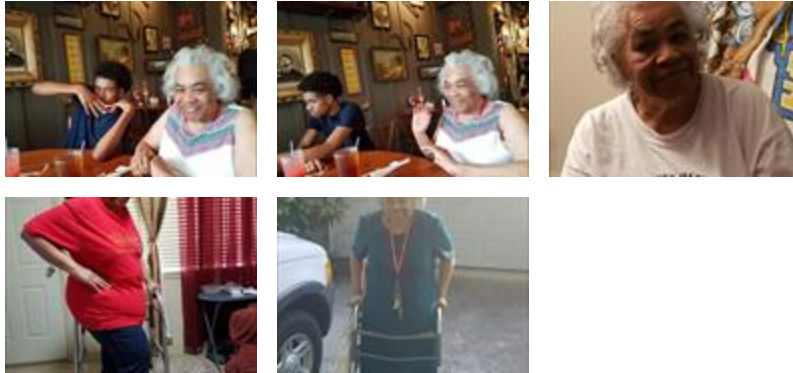
