This too, will help to sustain you as you grieve for your great loss.

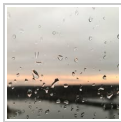

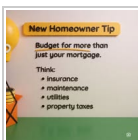

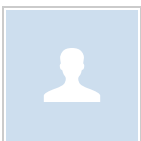
