Frederick Henry Tull, Jr. was born on October 30, 1956 in Philadelphia, PA to Frederick Henry Tull, Sr. and Eula Mae Allen-Tull. He graduated from The Roman Catholic High School for Boys, class of 1974. After graduation, Frederick enrolled in college and worked for the United States Internal Revenue Service. In May of 1978, shortly after becoming a father to his firstborn son James “Boom” Cosby, Frederick enlisted into the United States Air Force. With his military experience, he traveled the world, gained a wealth of knowledge, and formed enduring friendships that remained for many decades.

While stationed in Las Vegas, NV, Frederick met and married Teresa Bolar who was also enlisted in the Air Force at the time. By 1985, Frederick completed his service, and moved his wife to Atlanta, GA as their permanent residence. In the same year, he started his career with the United States Postal Service until he retired after 25 dedicated years. Frederick and Teresa had four children together: Aisha, Fred III, Sephire, and Jamila.

Frederick was a cherished leader, visionary, father, and friend. He was very proud of his five children and made it his mission to build a strong family and legacy for future generations to behold. His life is a story of excellence and strength, and he left an indelible impression on all who knew him. During his retirement, he enjoyed spending time with his family, writing poems, listening

to music, being outdoors, cycling, and talking with his buddies at his part-time job. His family honors him with so much pride and endless amounts of love.

Frederick departed his earthly life on January 29, 2021 and is preceded in death by his father, his mother, and his brother Danny Tull.
