God had need for a special angel, so He called the Rev. George Cook, Jr., your dear husband, father, grandfather and relatives, home above, but he's only as far as your heart, and he lives as before in your heart.

Rev. George Cook, Jr., was my pastor, at the Mount Ararat Missionary Baptist Church, Birmingham, Alabama for many years before he continued his calling to another church in North Carolina.

He married me at my parent's home in 1974, under his leadership I continued to grow, depend on my faith in God and sang in the Voices of Mt, Ararat choir; baptized my son John, as he continued to grow in faith and participated in church activities; provided support and prayers while we mourned John's death in 1995 caused by a drunk driver; and dedicated our daughter, Coretta back to God when she was an infant in 1979.

He was a loving, compassionate pastor whom showed love and helped others during the Civil Rights area, by driving another church's bus to transport people to various designations while the public buses were boycotted. Rev. Cook worked Baptist Bible College, other churches throughout Birmingham while Mount Ararat Church family supported him, including a loaded bus and several cars journeying to his installation services in North Carolina.

I and my family regret we are unable to attend his home going services, due to another long time member's home going service at Mount Ararat. The Cook family will remain in our prayers, from the family of the belated Richard and Rosie M. Lewis.

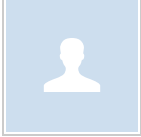
