Georgia Rose Veazie was born in Opelousas, LA, the eldest child of Caesar Veazie, Sr and Lillie Batiste Veazie (both deceased).

After completing her education from high school, she attended Grambling University, earning an A.A. From there, she enlisted in the WAC (Women's Army Corps) during WWII. She attained the level of Sgt-Supplier. After her military service, Georgia enrolled at Alabama A & M University in Huntsville, Alabama where she earned a B.A. in Education.

She met and married a veteran (Army) who was also attending Alabama A & M. To this union, one child was born; a daughter they named Yvonne. Ms. Georgia continued to pursue her career in Education. During her tenure, she taught Special Education, Elementary Education, and she also was a teacher of Reading. She also taught college courses during the summer at Alabama A & M and Rust College, MS. Her teaching included adult literacy, especially for military veterans.

Georgia accepted Christ into her life as a teen and walked diligently to serve Him all of her life. As a member of the First Missionary Baptist Church, Huntsville AL for 48 years, Georgia was a Sunday School teacher, chair of the Christian Board of Education, President of the Young Women's Society and an usher.
