



Geraldine Hall Crawford

July 6, 1950 - February 11, 2023

Geraldine (“Geri”) Hall Crawford was born on July 6, 1950, to the late Leonard Hall, Sr., and Mattie Louise Gaither.

She was the second of three children that impressed her as a “mediator” which formed the character

she displayed throughout her life. As a young child, Geri was nurtured in Judeo-Christian values as

she attended Allen Temple A.M.C. Church, and as a teenager she was confirmed a Christian and was

baptized by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., as she attended Ebenezer Baptist Church.

In August of 1973, she married Earl H. Crawford, a friend whom she knew for 12 years before they

courted and dated. He was attracted to her vivacious and joyful personality.

He loved Geri, and Geri

loved him. They reared one son, Clemence (“Clem”) Earl Crawford, that she instilled with good morals

and living principles implicit in her Christian faith. He is a veteran of the United States Navy and a

graduate of Florida A&M University.

In 1969, she graduated from Charles L. Harper High School. In the following year she attended Fall

College and took many of the courses offered by the American Institute of

Banking. Later, she enrolled at Dekalb Community College.

Her work experience consists of a shoe sales clerk at Butler Shoe Store, a coding operator with Trust

Company Bank, and at Dekalb County Georgia she was an office assistant and a valuable worker and

team player in the Code Enforcement Department.

She was very instrumental in helping her husband achieve success as a field auditor/financial analyst

in his 36 years of working in Commercial Finance. She rose early to take him to the Airport with her

toddler asleep on the back seat of the car, drop him off, drive to the nursery, and then go her place of

employment.

After retirement, she made a commitment to serve as a caregiver for three family members, including

her deceased mother, Mrs. Mattie Hall, her aunt, Burdell Partridge, and her aunt, Idella Miles. She had

a passion for interior decorating in their home and she appreciated the opportunity she had to honor

the accomplishments of others as both she and Earl invited guests, prepared, and served meals and

entertained family members in celebrating birthdays, baby showers, and graduations.

She also devoted her life to understanding the bible to gain greater spiritual wisdom and insight. About

six every morning she began her routine with studying bible lessons, meditating, and listening to gospel

and spiritual songs. She endeavored daily to lift up her family and friends with inspiration and spiritual

quotes and gems of truth via telephone calls and messages.

When she had completed her daily tasks, Geri caught up with the news and relaxed watching her favorite

Western movies while dozing off to sleep reclining on her sofa.

Geri was a loving and devoted wife, mother, sister, and friend. She enjoyed dining out with Earl, her

soulmate, and occasionally getting with friends.

Geri leaves to cherish her memories: loving husband, Earl Henry Crawford of Decatur, Georgia; one son,

Clemence Earl Crawford of Atlanta, GA; one brother, Leonard Hall, Jr., of Atlanta; one sister, Imogene

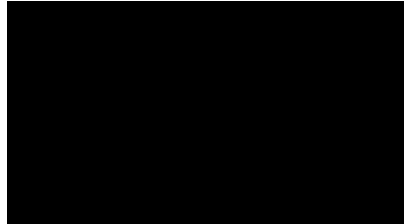
