She had a soft

appreciated a
good mystery (as long as Jessica Fletcher solved it in under 45 minutes).

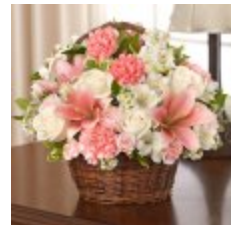
