Gloria attended the Anglican Church of England, in Birnamwood, Portland, where she also attended school. Gloria was known and loved by her family, neighbors and friends. She assisted in the delivery of babies in the neighboring district.

A young man from the parish of St. Thomas named Hubert M. Gilpin asked for her hand in marriage at the age of 19. Gloria was united in holy matrimony and relocated to Kingston, Jamaica. Gloria and Hubert had a total of 7 children as a result of this union. As the children grew, she went out to work as an office assistant for Mr. Laifoot, a local businessman. Gloria was very experienced in the arts and crafts: crochet, knitting, and sewing infant attire. Embracing her Jewish heritage, she ensured that her children attended Mountain View Seventh Day Baptist Church, to observe the Sabbath.

Gloria was a very kindhearted person who always put her family first, sacrificing her time and energy over herself. Her love and dedication to her family was evident in everything she did. Throughout her life, Gloria faced many challenges with grace and resilience. She had a strong spirit and

unwavering faith that guided her throughout her difficult times, always keeping her focus on God. She loved to sing and hum spiritual songs as she went throughout her days. One of her favorite songs was Abide with Me, and favorite scriptures included: Psalms 23, 27, 103 and Our Father Who art in Heaven.
