Gloria G. Mayo of Richmond, VA, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, July 7, 2020.

Born December 9, 1956, she was the daughter of the late Romelle G. Avent and James D. Cousins.

Ms. G, as she was affectionally known, is survived by her daughters, Chandra, Monique, and Candace; her mother-in-law, Helena; her sister, Marie; two brothers, Haskell and Terry; her sister-in-law, Nona; three nieces; three nephews; two great-nieces; eight great-nephews; two great-great-nieces; and seven great-great-nephews.

She loved the Lord and was active in the church for decades, was an ordained Apostle and Pastor, helped to start and grow many ministries such as Manna Christian Fellowship, Network of Christian Women, a radio show called Straight Ahead Ministries, and a church Inner Court International Ministries. Gloria has always been an avid fighter for the betterment of people and spent much of her time volunteering.

In times past, she was the director of many successful blood drives in Richmond (and won an award for the success and the high number of participants of the blood drive), was a coordinator for the Special Olympics in

Richmond, and helped with several organizations dealing with women and domestic violence. Ms. G loved spending time with her family, cooking, fine arts, interior decorating, and playing card games such as Gin Rummy and Solitaire. Gloria will always be remembered as a bright shining light in a dark world.

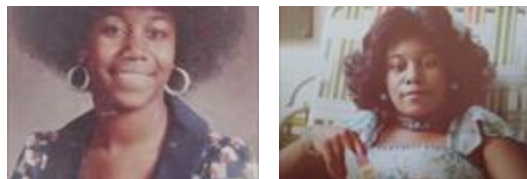
“ Dear Mayo family,
