She graduated from Bethune Cookman in 1965 with a Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education.

In alignment with her degree and passion for higher learning, Gloria taught elementary grades for a number of years throughout Florida.

On November 30, 1965 Gloria welcomed her one and only daughter, the apple of her eye, Kecia.

After retiring from the school system, Gloria worked at Macy's for a number of years as Administrator Assistant to the Men's Buyers Department where she met a host of people she would later call friends and whom remained in touch

until her passing.

It's said that Gloria never met a stranger. She was always willing to lend a helping hand. Even in the unlikeliest of situations. Affectionately known as a second mother to so many, Gloria imparted wisdom and support whenever given the opportunity.
