



Gregory Crocker

November 4, 1952 - February 13, 2025

Mr. Gregory “Greg” Crocker, 72, was born on November 4, 1952, in Fort Benning, Georgia, to the late Mae Francis Echols and Curtis Crocker, Sr. He was the eldest of three siblings. Greg is survived by his devoted wife, Constance Y. Walker Crocker, and their two daughters, Chiquita Renee Crocker and Tania Denese Crocker, as well as his beloved grandson, Caiden Michael Freeman.

In July 1991, Greg and Constance became dedicated members of Big Miller Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Stonecrest, GA. He was ordained as a deacon on February 22, 1997, under the leadership of Bishop Miles E. Fowler, D.D. At the church, he led various ministries, including Overcomers Through Christ and Habitat for Humanity, and actively participated in the Men’s Ministry, mentoring young men both in the church and the community.

Greg was a proud graduate of William H. Spencer High School in Columbus, GA, class of 1970. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Management and a Masters in Psychology from Tuskegee Institute (now Tuskegee University). A passionate musician, he loved to sing and played the trumpet and French horn, participating in marching bands throughout his educational journey.

Mr. Crocker enjoyed a distinguished career in the insurance industry. Known

as “The Insurance Godfather”, his expertise and leadership were highly respected, earning him admiration among colleagues. Greg retired as the Assistant Vice President of Claims at Chubb Insurance Company. He later continued his career as a Senior Claims Examiner for The Hartford.

He was also a cherished member of the Beta Lambda Lambda Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated, which he held dear to his heart.

Greg leaves behind a loving family, including his dear wife, Constance Crocker; daughters, Chiquita Crocker and Tania Crocker; grandson, Caiden; sons, Michael Crocker and Gregory Crocker, Jr.; and, his siblings: Dr. Judith D. Crocker Billingsley (Joseph Davis), Dr. Rebecca Crocker McMullen (Rev. Atty. Calvin McMullen), and Rev. Dr. Curtis Crocker, Jr., (Lessa Crocker). He is also survived by a host of beloved in-laws, cousins, nieces, and nephews of whom he greatly loved.

Gregory Crocker will be remembered for his unwavering faith, dedication to family, and commitment to service in his community.

A visitation will be held Thursday, February 20, 2025 from 12:00PM - 8:00PM at our Gwinnett Chapel; the Omega Psi Phi Memorial Service will begin at 1911hrs. A Celebration of Life will be held Friday, February 21, 2025 at 11:00AM at Big Miller Grove Missionary Baptist Church, Bishop Miles E. Fowler, Sr. Pastor.

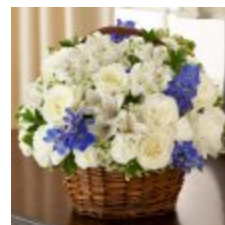

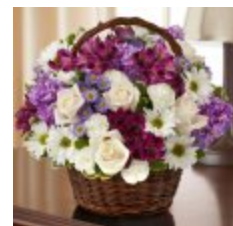
