Helen consistently worked to improve her knowledge by continuing to pursue additional certificates and degrees. Helen worked in a career that

Although Helen found her career of choice fulfilling the greatest passion in her life was her ministry. Helen accepted her calling to the ministry and was ordained as a minister.
